1. Grateful Palate Poor Boy Red 2020

- a. 50% Grenache, 50% Tempranillo, DO Calatayud, Spain
- b. Master winemaker Norrel Robertson, 60-80-year-old-vines
- c. Tertiary age soils, w/sand and clay subsoils
- d. Original bourbon-barrel aged w/PVW barrels—first in world to do so
- e. Pair with Shepherd's Pie, Ahi Tuna steaks and smoky BBQ

2. Jack Tar Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon 2020

- a. 100% Cabernet Sauvignon, Paso Robles, California
- b. 1500 case production, label inspired by "Rime of the Ancient Mariner"
- c. Aged 10 months in new and 2nd fill French oak
- d. Aromas of black cherry & tobacco, w/grilled plum, cigar box and plush middle
- e. Pair with pot roast, aged cheddar raclette and swordfish steaks

3. Durant & Booth Cabernet Sauvignon 2020

- a. 87% Cabernet Sauvignon, 6% Petit Verdot, 5% Merlot, 2% Petite Sirah, Napa Valley, CA
- b. Original founders of Oakville Grocery, bourbon-barrel aging
- c. 10 months in 25% new French oak
- d. Purple, w/fresh berries on nose, baked fruit and mocha on palate
- e. Pair with short ribs, lamb tenderloin and charred vegetables

4. Leviathan Red 2021

- a. **56% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot, 13% Petite Sirah, 7% Syrah, 5% Petite Verdot, 4% Cabernet Franc**
- b. Winemaker Andy Erickson—creates new blend each vintage to reflect differences
- c. Volcanic soils, 100% French oak for 15 months, 25% new
- d. Aromas of cola, cherry & spice, w/marjoram, white pepper and fine-grained tannins
- e. Pair with duck breast, BBQ beef ribs and Stilton Bleu cheese
